SUBJECT:	LEAKING UNDERGROUND FUEL TANK CLEANUP PROGRAM – Status Report
DISCUSSION:	Attached are three tables indicating progress made during the first three quarters of fiscal year 04-05 toward our underground fuel tank cleanup program goals. We are currently on track to exceed our goal of 30 case closures.
	In order to reduce costs to responsible parties and increase efficiency while maintaining groundwater protection, where appropriate we have reduced groundwater monitoring frequency to semi-annual, and in some cases annual. Consequently, the bulk of the required groundwater monitoring reports will not be received until later this year. At that time the number of monitoring report reviews will increase and come into line with our annual goal.
