ITEM: 6 SUBJECT: City of Sunnyvale, Water Pollution Control Plant, Santa Clara County -Hearing to Consider Mandatory Minimum Penalty for Discharge of Partially Treated Wastewater to Waters of the State CHRONOLOGY: September 2001 – Mandatory Minimum Penalty (MMP) August 2003 - MMP DISCUSSION: The City of Sunnyvale violated its NPDES effluent limits on eight occasions during the period between October 1, 2002, and August 31, 2004. Four of these violations are subject to mandatory penalties for a total penalty of \$12,000. The City has signed a waiver to a Water Board hearing (Appendix B), and intends to undertake a supplemental environmental project (SEP). The proposed SEP will supplement funding to the San Francisco Bay Bird Observatory (SFBBO) in Alviso for its Streamside Songbird Program. SFBBO is dedicated to the conservation of birds and their habitats through research, monitoring and educational activities. The attached complaint proposes civil liability in the amount of \$12,000, of which all will be suspended to fund the SEP. **RECOMMEN-**DATION: No action required.
