CHRONOLOGY: August 2000 - Permit Reissued

June 2001 – Permit Amended to Impose Updated Pretreatment Requirements

DISCUSSION: This item will be considered at the same time as the previous item for

EBDA. This permit is for one of the six treatment plants that discharge through the EBDA outfall. A separate permit is necessary because EBDA

has no legal authority to ensure compliance by Livermore.

Since the Tentative Order for Livermore is nearly identical to EBDA's, the comments received and our responses as presented in the EBDA package apply to both. In the attached response to comments are responses that apply only to Livermore's Tentative Order or that are different than responses for EBDA. We have addressed all the comments (Appendix C) and have successfully resolved most of them through revisions to the Tentative Order.

The Revised Tentative Order reflects all changes made since the circulation

of the original Tentative Order in June.
