Discharge Requirements/NPDES Permit for the City's Stormwater

Pollution Prevention Program

CHRONOLOGY: January 2000 – Stormwater Permit issued

DISCUSSION: The attached Tentative Order rescinds the stormwater permit for the

City of American Canyon because the permit is no longer needed. This Order was originally adopted to allow pollution trading between the City's then new sewage treatment plant and its stormwater

program. Since then, there has been no need for pollution trading

because the treatment plant has met all of its limits.

American Canyon received coverage for its stormwater discharge under the State Board's on January 10, 2006. This Permit, generally called the Phase 2 Municipal Stormwater Permit, is designed for smaller cities and is appropriate for American Canyon. American Canyon has joined Napa County and the other cities in Napa County

for a coordinated county wide stormwater program.
