SUBJECT: CLOVER FLAT LANDFILL, INC., VISTA CORPORATION, CLOVER FLAT LANDFILL, CALISTOGA, NAPA COUNTY – Adoption of Updated Waste Discharge Requirements and Rescission of Order No. 91-160

CHRONOLOGY: Waste Discharge Requirements adopted in 1991

DISCUSSION: This Tentative Order (Appendix A) updates Waste Discharge Requirements for the active Clover Flat Landfill. This landfill is an operating municipal solid waste disposal site located about three miles east of Calistoga and serves communities within the northwestern portion of Napa County. The landfill is expected to reach final capacity in 15 to 25 years.

The Tentative Order specifically:

- updates waste discharge requirements (WDRs) to reflect the construction of additional landfill cells, a new landfill gas extraction system, and changes to the groundwater and surface water monitoring programs;
- specifies liner construction requirements for future landfill cell construction consistent with current State and federal requirements;
- specifies monitoring, control, and collection requirements for groundwater, leachate, landfill gas, and storm water; and
- rescinds the existing WDRs (Order No. 91-160).

No comments were received during the public comment period, and the discharger has indicated its acceptance of the Tentative Order.
