SUBJECT: **Sanitary District No. 5 of Marin County, Tiburon Wastewater Treatment Plant, Tiburon, Marin County – Rescission of Cease & Desist Order**

CHRONOLOGY: July 2008 – Board reissues NPDES permit and adopts Cease & Desist Order

DISCUSSION: The attached Tentative Order would rescind the Cease & Desist Order (CDO) the Board adopted in July 2008. The purpose of the CDO was to address the District's inability to immediately comply with final effluent limits for selenium in the NPDES permit the Board reissued in July. Since the adoption of the CDO, the District has complied with the CDO's tasks and schedule and determined that laboratory errors were the cause of high selenium values found in its effluent. As the District has implemented new procedures to ensure the accuracy of selenium results, it now believes that it can comply with the selenium limits in its permit. Therefore, the CDO is no longer necessary.

We received no comments on the Tentative Order and expect this matter to be uncontested.
