NOTICE OF PENDING ENFORCEMENT ACTION
in the matter of

E – D Coat, Inc.

The Assistant Executive Officer of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (“Regional Water Board”) issued a complaint for administrative civil liability (“Complaint”) on May 17, 2013 to E – D Coat, Inc. (“Discharger”). The Discharger is allegedly responsible for violating a general permit for storm water discharges from industrial facilities by failing to submit an annual report of storm water discharge to the Regional Water Board by July 1, 2012, for the period July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012. For this alleged violation, the Assistant Executive Officer proposes assessing \$7,460 in liabilities pursuant to Water Code sections 13385 and 13399.

The Complaint and related documents, including the procedure for Regional Water Board hearings (with deadlines for submitting comments), are available at http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/sanfranciscobay/public_notices/pending_enforcement.shtml. The Complaint may be amended and re-noticed by the Assistant Executive Officer in response to comments from the Discharger or the public.

The Regional Water Board will hold a hearing on August 14, 2013 to consider adoption of the proposed administrative civil liability and/or referral of the matter to the Attorney General, unless the Discharger waives its right to a hearing within 90 days. The 90-day hearing requirement may be waived to pay the proposed penalty, extend deadlines, or pursue settlement and/or a supplemental environmental project.
