**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR
DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**Valero Refining Company-California, Valero Benicia Refinery
3400 East Second Street, Benicia, Solano County**

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The Valero Benicia Refinery processes crude oil and its wastewater is treated and discharged to Suisun Bay through a submerged outfall approximately 1,100 feet offshore near the Benicia Bridge. The refinery also discharges stormwater to Sulphur Springs Creek, Suisun Bay, and Carquinez Strait.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is 5:00 p.m. on July 9, 2015. Comments must be sent to the **attention of John H. Madigan**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **August 12, 2015**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street, Oakland. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
