**NOTICE OF APPLICATION, OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT, AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR
DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**Fairfield-Suisun Sewer District, Fairfield-Suisun Wastewater Treatment Plant
1010 Chadbourne Road, Fairfield, Solano County**

The above discharger has filed an application for permit reissuance under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System. Board staff has prepared a draft permit in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The discharger owns a treatment plant, which treats municipal wastewater from the City of Fairfield, Suisun City, and Travis Air Force Base. The plant serves about 136,000 people and has a dry weather capacity of 23.7 million gallons per day. Treated, disinfected wastewater discharges to Boynton Slough, Ledge Creek, and duck ponds in Suisun Marsh.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is 5:00 p.m. on January 26, 2015.

Comments must be sent to the **attention of John H. Madigan**. Persons wishing to file written comments on the draft permit or other aspects of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **March 11, 2015**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street in Oakland. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
