**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR
DISCHARGE PERMIT AND CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AMENDMENT**

**City of Calistoga, Dunaweal Wastewater Treatment Plant
1100 Dunaweal Lane, Calistoga, Napa County**

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act. Board staff has also prepared a draft cease and desist order amendment.

The Dunaweal Wastewater Treatment Plant treats City of Calistoga wastewater and has a dry weather treatment capacity of 0.84 million gallons per day. During wet weather, treated wastewater is disinfected and discharged through outfalls to the Napa River. Otherwise, treated wastewater is recycled for irrigation. The draft permit would continue to authorize the wet-weather discharges. The draft cease and desist order amendment would extend current requirements to a new discharge point and add tasks and deadlines to reduce chlorodibromomethane and dichlorobromomethane discharge concentrations.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit and cease and desist order amendment is 5:00 p.m. on January 19, 2016. Comments must be sent to the **attention of John H Madigan**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit and cease and desist order amendment during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **March 9, 2016**, in the Auditorium of 1515 Clay Street, Oakland. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to section 2050(c) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, any party that challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence.

All documents related to the draft permit and cease and desist order amendment may be inspected at the Board office.
