**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) staff will hold a public workshop and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) scoping meeting to seek public input regarding the scope, content, and potential impacts of the North Bay Selenium TMDL Basin Plan amendment at the time and location provided above. The amendment would establish a TMDL and Implementation Plan for selenium in the North San Francisco Bay.

#### MEETING FORMAT

The meeting will consist of a public workshop where we will provide a description of the TMDL, followed by a question and answer session. Immediately following the workshop, Water Board staff will open a public scoping meeting, pursuant to CEQA (Public Resources Code §21000 et seq.), on the TMDL project. The Water Board is required by CEQA to evaluate the potential environmental impacts of the TMDL and will incorporate this environmental analysis into the TMDL staff report and Basin Plan amendment.
