**Subject: Deadlines for submittals required by Directives 12 through 14 of Order No. R2-2013-1005-A1, Lehigh Southwest Cement Company, 24001 Stevens Creek Blvd, Santa Clara County.**

Dear Ms. Granquist:

This letter responds to your September 20, 2013, request to delay the submittal of technical reports required by Directives 12 through 14 of amended Order No. R2-2013-1005-A1, pursuant to California Water Code section 13267. I hereby grant your request as modified and explained below.

Directives 12 through 14 require a *Site History Description*, a *Source Investigation Work Plan*, and a *Source Investigation Report*, respectively, to identify potential sources of pollution from past and current operations and to conduct an investigation to confirm where pollutants may be present in soil and groundwater. Documents submitted to date have not been adequate to characterize sources of pollution, as required by Order No. R2-2013-1005 (amended as Order No. R2-2013-1005-A1).

I find your request acceptable with one modification to the extension for Directive 14. The extension for this deadline was based on "completion of work," which is not adequately constrained. We agree not to initiate enforcement action provided that the required reports are submitted as follows:

- Submit the *Site History Description* (Directive 12) **by December 1, 2013;**
- Submit the *Source Investigation Work Plan* (Directive 13) **within 60 days** of my acceptance of the Directive 12 *Site History Description* report.
- Submit a *Source Investigation Report* (Directive 14) **within 120 days** of my acceptance of the Directive 13 *Source Investigation Work Plan*.


