RESOLUTION NO. 75-12

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 598 RELATIVE TO WAIVING REPORTS ON
WASTE DISCHARGE FROM FAMILY DWELLINGS IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, on September 17, 1964, this Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 598 a policy relative to waiving of reports on waste discharge from family dwellings in areas where the disposal of sewage is regulated by the Solano County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, Solano County had permitted and was considering developments using septic tank systems contrary to the above policy; and

WHEREAS, the Solano County Board of Supervisors has amended its code providing for the regulation of individual sewage disposal systems which is in substantial conformance with the Regional Board's policies; and

WHEREAS, Solano County's Code would allow planned unit developments to occur on septic tank systems on lots as small as one acre minimum; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this Regional Board amends its Resolution No. 598 by adding VI G to read:

"G. That this waiver does not apply to any planned unit development when the minimum lot size is less than two and one half (2½) acres."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Regional Board commends the Solano County Board of Supervisors for its action.
