<p>Comments:</p> <p>During FY 10-11, the City of Dublin conducted a total of 86 construction inspections. The City of Dublin inspects all construction sites, including those sites that disturb less than 1 acre.</p> <p>There were a total of 12 sites that disturbed 1 acre or more, which included the following projects:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Vailey Christian Sanctuary Building – a new building at an existing church/school in the City. 2. Schaefer Ranch – single family residential homes. 3. Dublin Blvd. Widening – an expansion of a portion of an existing roadway in the City from 1 lane to 2 lanes (in west bound direction). 4. DR Horton Cortona – single family residential homes. 5. Kolb School – elementary school. 6. Sorrento West – medium density residential homes. 7. Fallon Village – single family residential homes. 8. Lennar - single family residential homes. 9. Livorno @ Positano – single family residential homes. 10. Fallon Gateway – commercial center. The only building currently under construction is the Target building. 11. Dublin Nissan – car dealership. 12. Dublin Historic Park – City Park, which includes the placement of historical buildings on the site. <p>There were two projects that disturbed less than an acre of land that were inspected, which include the following projects:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Village Parkway Stormwater treatment – the installation of a swale near the 680 freeway on-ramp. 2. PG&E Gas main & Primary conduit installation.
