Subject: Requirement to Submit 2010-11 Construction Site Inspection Information

Dear Mr. Wolfe:

Thank you and your staff for taking time to review the City's Annual Stormwater NPDES report and providing comment. The City of Pleasanton (City) has received your letter dated December 2, 2011, requesting submittal of Provision C6 (Construction Site Inspection) information in tabular format.

The City of Pleasanton has developed the requested information in tabular format and electronically, in accordance with your request and in compliance with the Municipal Regional Permit (MRP) Provisions C.6.E.ii.(4) and C.6.e.iii.(3). The requested information will be uploaded to the Regional Water Board's ftp site and emailed to your staff, Ms. Selina Louie.

In reviewing our submittal please note the following:

- 1) In the City's Annual 2010-11 Stormwater Report, for the question regarding "Number of sites disturbing \geq 1 acre of soil", we reported four (4) sites. In the tabular report that we are now submitting, this number is reported as seven (7) sites. The reason for this discrepancy is because inspection of the City's construction sites are performed by two separate City divisions and each division performs a different aspect of construction inspections. Each division also prepares a separate tabular report for construction inspections. In the Annual Report we noted that there were three sites that were inspected by both Building and Public Works Inspection Divisions. We removed duplicate numbers and reported this as "4". However, now that we have combined the two inspection lists, inspection sites from both divisions are being totaled and therefore showing as "7".



- 2) In the City's Annual Report, for "Violations not fully corrected within 30 days after violations are discovered (C.6.e.iii.1.i), we reported three (3) sites. In reviewing the combined tabular data we noted that this number should have been reported as four (4). However, the total number of violations, including those corrected within 10 days in 2010-11 remains "53". Accordingly, the number for "Violations fully corrected within 10 business days after violations are discovered or otherwise considered...(C.6e.iii.1.h) is now changed to "49". I have revised these numbers and associated percentages in Provision C.6 portion of the Annual Report and resubmitting for your record. The revised file is named "Pleasanton_2010-11_AR_C6_Revised" and uploaded to the ftp site.

Please feel free to contact me if you need clarification for the tabular information and also the clarification I have provided in this letter.
