Justification

Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot (Attach additional photos as necessary):

The City of Fremont's Environmental Services Division conducts over 10 creek/street cleanups per year. As a result of these cleanups, the amount of pounds was counted during each cleanup and annually over time. This creek was selected as the top seven hot spots that contain the most trash present through either multiple or all the following ways: accumulation, littering, windblown, or illegal dumping.

The Laguna Creek "A" Hot Spot receives trash by littering and illegal dumping from nearby retail businesses and multi-family dwellings. Accumulation of trash in the creek comes from upstream that consists mostly of storm drain underground piping and above surface grates through both single-family homes and multi-family dwellings.

Cleanups are conducted along over 167 yards of Laguna Creek that includes the Laguna Creek "A" Hot Spot at least twice per year.
