


# TRASH HOT SPOT SELECTION FORM

## Site Information

**Waterbody:** San Francisco Bay

**Site Location:** This site is located along the shoreline of San Francisco Bay in Hayward. The minimum site location selected for clean-up traverses 100 yards to the south and north of where the middle access trail intersects the public trail along the shoreline. This section of the Bay Trail is accessed from the staging area at the end of West Winton Avenue. This site is located in the Hayward Regional Shoreline Park that is managed by the East Bay Regional Park District.

## Justification

Staff selected this location as it's historically been a frequent location of transportable and buoyant litter that accumulates along the shoreline. Upon inspection, there are also large amounts of broken glass along the shoreline in the areas where the tide is the highest (pictures attached below). This site is on the 303(d) list of impaired water bodies for trash. Staff followed the site selection process outlined in the ACCWP Trash Load Reduction Work Group Hot Spot Selection Guidance document.

Annual California Coastal Cleanup Day data will be submitted for this site, and will most likely include additional Hayward shoreline locations subject to trash accumulation via tidal action, stormwater runoff, as well as windborne sources.
