Justification

Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot (Attach additional photos as necessary):

The City of San Leandro has approximately 5 miles of shoreline along the eastern shore of San Francisco Bay. In addition, San Leandro Creek, which originates and terminates in Oakland, runs through northern San Leandro. City staff visually inspected and assessed the bay shoreline and accessible portions of San Leandro Creek using the attached Alameda County Clean Water Program Hot Spot Field Screening Worksheet. Based on the five criteria, the City selected the four areas that ranked highest on the list.

Long Beach is located along San Francisco Bay at the southern tip of San Leandro. The site is accessible to the public from the Bay Trail. Much of the litter found is windblown across the bay and is transportable, buoyant and persistent. Some of the litter is from groups that use the beach for picnics and bonfires and primarily consists of beverage containers.
