Dear Mr. Jones:

Enclosed is a copy of Mandatory Penalties Complaint No. R8-2004-0105. The complaint is in response to violations of effluent limitations specified in your waste discharge requirements, Order No. 01-95. It was issued pursuant to California Water Code Section 13385 (i) and proposes the assessment of a penalty of \$9,000 for three violations that occurred between February 2004 and April 2004.

Should you wish to waive your right to a public hearing on this matter, please sign the enclosed waiver form and submit it, along with the bottom portion of the attached invoice and a check or money order for the amount of \$9,000, by December 2, 2004, to the address on the invoice. YOU ARE HEREBY GIVEN NOTICE THAT:

1. The Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) is alleged to have violated provisions of law for which the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Board), Santa Ana Region, must impose mandatory penalties pursuant to California Water Code (Water Code) Section 13385 (h) and (i).
2. A hearing concerning this complaint will be held before the Board during the Board's regular meeting on December 20, 2004 at the Loma Linda City Council Chambers, 25541 Barton Road, Loma Linda, unless IRWD waives its right to a hearing. Waiver procedures are specified on Page 2 of this complaint. IRWD or its representatives will have an opportunity to appear and be heard and to contest the allegations in this complaint and the imposition of mandatory penalties by the Board.
3. This complaint is based on the following facts:
 - a. On December 19, 2001, the Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. 01-95 (NPDES No. CA8000326), for IRWD. These requirements regulate discharges of waste from the Michelson Water Reclamation Plant.
 - b. IRWD submitted self-monitoring reports (February 2004 through April 2004) for the Michelson Water Reclamation Plant, which show effluent limit violations of chlorine residual entering the Rattlesnake Reservoir on February 25, March 3, and April 28, 2004.
4. Water Code Section 13385 (h) and (i) requires the Board to assess a mandatory minimum penalty of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for each serious violation. All of the violations noted above are considered serious violations.
5. In accordance with Water Code Section 13385(c), the Board may impose administrative civil liability for the three violations noted above. The maximum administrative civil liability that may be imposed for these violations is \$30,000 (\$10,000 per day of violation), plus an additional assessment of \$10 per gallon of effluent discharged during the duration of the violation episode, in excess of the first 1000 gallons of effluent.

6. The Executive Officer proposes that mandatory penalties of \$9,000 be imposed on IRWD by the Board for the violations cited above.

You may waive your right to a hearing. If you waive your right to a hearing, please sign the attached waiver, which is Page 3 of this complaint, and return it together with a check payable to the State Water Resources Control Board in the amount of the mandatory penalties proposed in paragraph 6, above.

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD) is alleged to have violated provisions of law for which the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region, must impose Mandatory Minimum Penalties, pursuant to California Water Code Section 13385. IRWD is alleged to have violated chlorine residual limits contained in its waste discharge requirements, Order No. 01-95, between February 2004 and April 2004.

On the basis of preliminary staff review and application of lawful standards and regulations, Complaint No. R8-2004-0105 for mandatory minimum penalties was issued to IRWD by the Executive Officer of the Regional Board on November 16, 2004. The complaint proposes a mandatory minimum penalty of \$ 9,000.

The complaint and related documents may be inspected and copied at the Regional Board office at 3737 Main Street, Suite 500, Riverside, California, by appointment between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday.
