
Rescission of Waste Discharge Requirements  
for  
Specific Dischargers

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (hereinafter Board), finds that:

1. The Orders listed in Attachment "A" were issued by the Board at various times to dischargers described therein. Attachment "A" is hereby made a part of this Order. The waste discharge requirements and enforcement orders for the dischargers listed in Attachment "A" are no longer necessary because the discharge has ceased, the facility is no longer in operation, the cleanup project has been completed and the discharger is in compliance with its enforcement order, or because the discharger has failed to pay annual permit fees.
2. This action is based on the fact that specific discharges have ceased or the project has been completed or that enforcement orders have been satisfied. As such, this action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act in accordance with Section 15061(b)(3), Chapter 3, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
3. The Board has notified the dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind the Orders for the facilities listed in Attachment "A" and has provided them with an opportunity to submit written comments and recommendations.
4. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescission of waste discharge requirements.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Orders listed in Attachment "A" be rescinded.
