15. Regional Board Member and Executive Officer Communications

Chair Beswick announced that a public workshop was scheduled to take place August 3, 2009 at the Loma Linda City Council Chambers, by a panel of regional board members, concerning the draft San Bernardino Flood Control Stormwater Permit and the Riverside Co. Stormwater Permit.

Mr. Thibeault said that Riverside County had asked for a postponement of the workshop for the Riverside County Stormwater Permit. The Riverside County representative was told that, because of the similarities of both the recently adopted Orange County Stormwater Permit, the draft San Bernardino County Flood Control District permit, and the draft Riverside County permit, and because of Riverside County's participation consideration of the earlier permits, as well as scheduling difficulties later in the year, their request was denied.

16. Closed Session

Mr. Ted Cobb announced that the Board would convene to a closed session to consider the appointment/employment evaluation and performance or dismissal of a public employee under Gov. Code Section 11126(a)1, and then reconvene at the end of the closed session, back into the public session to announce the results of the closed session.

Following the closed session, the Board returned to the public portion of the meeting. The Board acknowledged that Mr. Thibeault would resign as Executive Officer, effective close of business, July 20, 2009, that he is exercising his mandatory right of return to Supervising WRCE (Mgr), and that the Board had appointed him as Acting Executive Officer, effective upon his resignation as Executive Officer. Mr. Cobb indicated that he would prepare a closed session memorandum.

Chair Beswick announced that Member PonTell will chair the August 3rd workshop in Loma Linda.

There was general discussion concerning the WQCC scheduled for October 26 & 27, 2009, in Sacramento.

Mr. Thibeault said the OCSD information item scheduled for the July 10th meeting may be canceled, and when the draft OCSD permit is ready to be released, consideration of that permit will be scheduled for the next available Board Meeting.
