- *6. **Waste Discharge Requirements and Master Reclamation Permit for City of Anaheim, Water Recycling Demonstration Project** - The proposed order will regulate the production and use of tertiary-treated recycled water by the City of Anaheim. The Water Recycling Demonstration Project includes the production of tertiary treated wastewater and its subsequent reclamation through a recycled water distribution system for various uses including landscape irrigation.

- *7. **General Waste Discharge Requirements for Site Maintenance and Water Quality Monitoring at Closed, Abandoned, or Inactive (CAI) Landfills within the Santa Ana Region** – This Order establishes minimum standards for detection monitoring, site maintenance, and reporting at CAI Landfills, pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 27, §20080(g). The Order will ensure that CAI Landfills do not degrade water quality or cause nuisance conditions and will provide consistency for regulation of CAI Landfills within the Santa Ana Region under a uniform set of waste discharge requirements.
