- \*8. **Revised Waste Discharge Requirements for CalPortland Company, Colton Facility** - In preparation for site closure, Order No. 78-059 is being revised to prescribe waste discharge requirements for disposal of cement kiln dust and other mining and plant operations wastes for quarry reclamation. The revised order also includes effluent limits for the discharge of wastewater to a surface impoundment consistent with the current water quality objectives for the underlying groundwater management zone.

11. **Basin Monitoring Program Task Force: Approval of Groundwater Management Zone Ambient Quality** - Pursuant to the Salt Management Plan specified in the Basin Plan, every three years, total dissolved solids (TDS) and nitrate-nitrogen ambient water quality concentrations are to be determined for each groundwater management zone within the Region. Task Force consultants have completed their update of the ambient water quality as well as interpretative analysis of the results and will present the findings. The Regional Board will consider acceptance of the updated ambient quality determinations.
