11. Status Report on General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sewage Collection Agencies in Orange County

Ken Theisen, Staff Environmental Scientist, presented a status report on sewage spills in Orange County and efforts by sewer agencies to comply with the requirements of Order No. R8-2002-0014, Waste Discharge Requirements for Sewage Collection Agencies in Orange County. A summary of significant reductions in sewage spill discharge volumes that impacted beach water quality in the region during the past year was discussed. He also discussed efforts to develop and implement programs and legal authority to control the discharge of fats, oils and grease that cause many sewage spills.

12. General Waste Discharge Requirements, (NPDES NO. CAG998002) — Issuance of General Waste Discharge Requirements for short-term groundwater-related discharges and de-minimus wastewater discharges to surface waters within the San Diego Creek/Newport Bay Watershed. (Postponed from the April 30, 2004 Board Meeting) - Order No. R8-2004-0021.

14. Basin Plan Amendment Workshop — Incorporation of Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for Nutrients for Lake Elsinore and Canyon Lake

Cindy Li, Engineering Geologist, presented an overview of the TMDL program and the watershed. She described the elements of TMDLs, as required by the Clean Water Act. She then discussed the proposed TMDLs for Canyon Lake and Lake Elsinore, including waste load and load allocations. The proposed implementation plan and monitoring plan were presented as well.

Kurt Berchtold, Assistant Executive Officer, provided an update on the progress of investigation of perchlorate pollution in this area. A DVD titled, "Perchlorate, a Blast from the Past, prepared by the California State University, San Bernardino, Water Resources Institute, was shown.

16. General NPDES Dairy Permit Re-Issuance Schedule

Gerard Thibeault, Executive Officer, recommended to the Board a delay in the consideration of re-issuance of the general NPDES dairy permit until after State Board and Office of Administrative Law approval of the basin plan amendment, including a salt management plan for the Santa Ana Basin, adopted by the Regional Board in January 2004. He indicated that the State Board intends to take up consideration of the BPA in September 2004, with consideration by the

Office of Administrative Law consideration later in the fall. The Board expressed general concurrence with this recommendation.

17. Mandatory Penalties Complaint – Atlantic Richfield Company, Service Station at 5981 Warner Avenue, City of Huntington Beach. The liability was paid and discharger waived its right to a hearing. No Board action was required.
