16. Regional Board Member and Executive Officer Communications

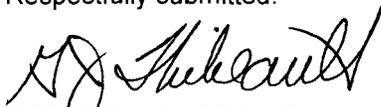

Executive Officer Thibeault reported that he, David Rice, Erik Spiess, and Hope Smythe have been working with the City of Pomona and the city of Claremont, which are cities that are located outside of the Santa Ana Region but discharge into our Region. Pomona and Claremont are subject to a TMDL for the Middle Santa Ana River (MSAR). The City of Pomona and the City of Claremont have now agreed to join the (MSAR) Task Force and are willing to participate in the monitoring efforts of the task force.
