The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (hereinafter Board), finds that:

1. The waste discharge requirements, Order No. R8-2002-0005, for the City of Tustin's Desalter Facility was issued by the Board on July 19, 2002. This Order for the facility is no longer necessary because the facility is now regulated pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Regional Board's General Permit, Order No. R8-2004-0021.
2. This action is based on the fact that the specific discharge is now regulated under Order No. R8-2004-0021. As such, this action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act in accordance with Section 15061(b)(3), Chapter 3, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
3. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind the Order for the facility and has provided them with an opportunity to submit written comments and recommendations.
4. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescission of waste discharge requirements.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Order No. R8-2002-0005 be rescinded.


