<p>Addition of a High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane and a mix-flow lane in each direction of Interstate 5 north of I-91 to just north of the Los Angeles-Orange County line in the City of Buena Park. The project will require the widening of the Fullerton Creek Bridge. Fullerton Creek is a concrete lined trapezoidal channel with inadequate capacity to convey the 100-year storm according to Orange County flood control standards and will eventually be modified into a concrete-lined channel with vertical banks. The project lies within both the Los Angeles Regional Board and Santa Ana Regional Board boundaries. However, since the discharge of fill to waters of the State occurs in the Santa Ana Region, the project has been deferred to the Santa Ana Regional Board for Certification.</p>
