**AMENDMENT OF CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY  
STANDARDS CERTIFICATION FOR THE IRONWOOD AVENUE AND INDIAN BASIN  
DETENTION BASIN PROJECT, CITY OF MORENO VALLEY, RIVERSIDE COUNTY  
(SARWQCB Project No. 332009-18)**

Dear Ms. Lazarus:

This is in reply to your June 2, 2011 request to amend the June 9, 2010 Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality standards certification (Certification) for the City's Ironwood Avenue and Indian Basin Detention Basin Project (Project). You request a Certification amendment that recognizes that the Project's temporary impacts to riparian waters of the U.S. (within Indian Basin) are increased from 0.102 acres to 0.262 acres, an addition of 0.16 acres, and that the Project includes approximately 307 cubic yards that is to be dredged from within the basin. These changes to the Project reflect the need to conduct maintenance within the basin so that the project described in the Certification can function as designed.


The June 9, 2011 Certification for the Project is hereby amended to recognize that the Project will temporarily impact a total of 0.262 riparian acres of waters of the U.S., and that the project will result in the dredging of approximately 307 cubic yards from a water of the U.S. These changes to the Project do not create impacts to water quality standards for which additional mitigation is necessary. All other terms and conditions of the subject Certification remain in effect
