**TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
ORDER NO. R8-2007-0018 HOMELAND/ROMOLAND MASTER DEVELOPMENT
PLAN (SARWQCB FILE NO. 332006-51)**

Dear Mr. Peters:

This is in response to Homeland/Romoland ADP, Inc.'s September 2, 2014, letter concerning Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R8-2007-0018 (Order). This Order authorized Homeland/Romoland ADP, Inc., (the Corporation) to discharge fill to waters of the state as part of its project to construct Phase 1 of the Homeland/Romoland Master Development Plan (Project), part of a master planned flood control facility. Discharges of fill to waters of the state are regulated because these discharges adversely impact the water quality standards of the receiving water.

We understand that the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District's (the District) and the Corporation have entered into an agreement to construct Stages 3 and 4 of the Line A Project. In its letter, the Corporation requests that the Board's Executive Officer authorize the transfer of responsibility to the District to make the impacts to waters of the state that the Order allows, that is, to excavate and discharge fill into state waters, subject to the requirements of the Order.

Provided the proposed construction activity is consistent with the terms of the Order, Board staff has no objection to the District carrying out the impacts to waters of the state that are described in the Order. No other regulatory action by this office is needed to allow the District to construct the Project.
