Conditional Early Settlement Offer No. SWB-2008-4-0049 with Mandatory Minimum Penalties against LA CO Parking Authority

On December 9, 2008, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) issued Offer to Participate in Expedited Payment Program No. SWB-2008-2-0049 to LA CO Parking Authority for alleged violations of Regional Board Order No. 97-045 WDID No. 4B1960000076 for the Walt Disney Hall Parking. On April 23, 2009, LA CO Parking Authority accepted the State Board's offer to participate in the Expedited Payment Program and Waived their right to a hearing.
