We are a local public agency (Pub. Res. Code, §9022) charged with, among other things, managing the “control of runoff, the prevention or control of soil erosion, the development and distribution of water and the improvement of land capabilities” (Pub. Res. Code, §9151).

Does the EKCRCD meet the requirements for a local agency as defined by SGMA?

Could the EKCRCD form a GSA and be deemed a legal GSA by the state?
