Project Purpose - Problem Being Addressed: This project will reduce the mercury sediment load that enters Las Tablas Creek and Lake Nacimiento from Cypress Mountain Drive, an unpaved County road in rural Adelaida. Project work includes capping (paving) 3.3 miles of road with asphalt, upgrading road drainage, stabilizing approximately 400 feet of streambank, and installing approximately 600 feet of roadside vegetated filter strips to reduce erosion, sedimentation, and dust generation from the road.	
4. Project Goals	
a. Short-term Goals: (1) Assess the extent of mercury contamination in the road and locate sediment inputs; (2) Provide stakeholder outreach and opportunity to input on the road project; (3) Design and construct erosion and sediment control management measures; and (4) Assess the performance of the management measures in reducing the mercury sediment loading.	
b. Long-term Goals: Reduce the mercury sediment loading coming from Cypress Mountain Drive
