3. Project Purpose - Problem Being Addressed: This project brings together federal and local non-profit entities to solve significant non-point source sedimentation problems in the Truckee watershed. The goal of this collaborative effort is the early implementation of the Truckee River sediment TMDL via restoration and education.

a. Short-term Goals: 1) Acquire in-holdings of 980 acres from a willing seller in Perazzo Meadows; 2) restore two severely degraded yet highly valued riparian/stream and meadow sites	
b. Long-term Goals: 1) Increased hydrologic function of stream and floodplain; 2) Decreased erosion from bed and banks; 3) Increased filtering of upland flows; 4) Increased riparian and aquatic habitats; 5) Increased water capacity of seasonal water table.	
5. Project Location: (lat/longs, watershed, etc.) Perazzo Meadows, in the Little Truckee River Basin, exact restoration project locations still to be determined through watershed assessment

Physical Size of Project: (miles, acres, sq. ft., etc.) About 275 acres of riparian and wetland habitat have been degraded by being de-watered due to stream diverting and/or drying out due to stream down cutting. These areas will be re-watered by the project; the exact size of the work areas is still to be determined by the watershed assessment.
