3. Project Purpose - Problem Being Addressed: This project addresses the problem of bacteria entering Santa Monica Bay through urban runoff in a storm drain that flows untreated to the ocean. This contaminated water affects marine life and beach water quality, posing a threat to public health.	
4. Project Goals	
a. Short-term Goals: This project's short-term goal is to divert dry weather low-flows in storm drain Project No. 286 to a sanitary sewer for treatment, thereby removing a source of bacteria to Santa Monica Bay.	
b. Long-term Goals: By removing a source of bacteria, it is expected that the number of dry weather beach postings and closures due to unsafe elevated bacteria levels will be decreased. It is also expected that overall ocean water will improve since trash and other pollutants will also be diverted from the storm drain.
