

## 2010/2011 Clean Water State Revolving Fund Project Priority List

\*\*\*\*IMPORTANT NEWS\*\*\*\*

The Division of Financial Assistance (Division) will be updating the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Program Project Priority List (PPL) for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2010/2011. Even if your project is already listed on the [2009/2010 CWSRF PPL](#) it is imperative that you log into FFAST to update your information to be included on the 2010/2011 CWSRF PPL.

The Division updates and publishes the CWSRF Program PPL each SFY in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Federal regulations. **Your project must appear on the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) adopted PPL to be eligible to receive financial assistance.** CWSRF funds can be used for construction of wastewater treatment and water reclamation facilities, correction of non-point source and storm drainage pollution problems, and implementation of estuary enhancement activities.

The initial update period for the 2010/2011 CWSRF Program PPL starts on January 11, 2010. The Final PPL will be considered for adoption by the State Water Board in June 2010. For the complete [2009/2010 CWSRF PPL](#) adoption schedule please see the [Tentative Adoption Schedule](#).

The Division will use the Financial Assistance Application Submittal Tool ([FFAST](#)) to accept all additions, deletions, and changes to the PPL.

For **applicants with new projects NOT** on the 2009/2010 CWSRF PPL, please select [Instructions for New Projects](#) and follow the directions to add your projects to the PPL.

For **applicants with existing projects** on the PPL and need to make any changes, please select [Instructions for Existing Projects](#) and follow the direction.

**Being listed on the PPL is not an application for CWSRF Program financing. All applicants must submit a [separate application](#) to receive financing from the CWSRF Program, and only projects on the adopted PPL may receive financial assistance.**

In accordance with the [CWSRF Policy](#), Section IV (G), the Division shall monitor progress of Projects on the PPL to assure the applicants are proceeding expeditiously with their Projects. If applicants do not proceed with project construction or request that a Project remain on the PPL within five years of initial placement on the PPL, the Project will be removed from the PPL if no response is received.
