


**AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009
SECTION 1511 CERTIFICATION**

The authorized representative of the State Water Board hereby certifies, and/or affirms that the Northeast Package Area 1 – 1630E Recycled Water Pipeline Project (Project) has received the full review and vetting required by law and that such representative accepts responsibility that the Project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. The following general description is provided in order to comply with Section 1511 of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA):

- Project description: The Project consists of 13,000 linear feet of 36-inch diameter recycled water pipeline that will convey recycled water from the 1299E Reservoir site to San Sevaine Basin Number 5 groundwater recharge site, located north of the intersection of the 210 and 15 Freeways, in the City of Rancho Cucamonga.
- Estimated total cost of the Project: Twelve million four hundred seventy two thousand five hundred dollars and no cents (\$12,472,500).
- Type of assistance: 20 year-term financing at zero percent (0%) interest.
- Estimated amount of ARRA funds to be used: Ten million two hundred five thousand seven hundred twenty four dollars and no cents (\$10,205,724).
