CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL FLOWS FRAMEWORK: OVERVIEW, APPLICATION, AND TOOLS

Description: The <u>California Environmental Flows Framework</u> (CEFF) is a management approach to efficiently develop scientifically defensible environmental flow recommendations that balance human and ecological needs for water. CEFF was developed to help managers improve the speed, consistency, standardization, and technical rigor in establishing environmental flow recommendations statewide. This workshop will provide an overview of CEFF, introduce technical tools that were developed to support CEFF implementation, and highlight case study applications that address a suite of management questions. The workshop will include presentations and interactive elements, including a demonstration of CEFF tools, and will be oriented towards practitioners working to assess and protect environmental flows in California's rivers and streams.

<u>Materials needed:</u> If you are interested in participating in a hands-on demonstration of CEFF tools, including the <u>natural flows database</u> (web-based) and <u>functional flows calculator R package</u>, please bring your laptop. The functional flows calculator R demonstration will require personal laptops with R Studio installed (https://rstudio-education.github.io/hopr/starting.html).
