**SUBJECT: MINOR, NON-SUBSTANTIVE CHANGES TO THE BASIN PLAN
AMENDMENT ADOPTED UNDER LOS ANGELES REGIONAL WATER
QUALITY CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. R2007-014**

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) adopted an amendment to the Los Angeles Water Quality Control Plan (Basin Plan) on September 6, 2007 under Resolution No. R2007-014 that readopts a Total Maximum Daily Load for metals in the Los Angeles River and its impaired tributaries. Regional Board Resolution No. R2007-014 grants the Executive Officer the authority to make minor, non-substantive changes to the language of the adopted resolution if Regional Board staff, the State Board, or OAL determines that such changes are needed for clarity or consistency. I am hereby making the following minor, non-substantive corrections to Resolution No. R2007-014. The changes are shown below using underline text to show insertions and ~~strikeout~~ text to show deletions.

Page 1, Finding paragraph 1, "On June 2, 2005, the Regional Board established, by Resolution No. ~~2005-006~~ R05-006, an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region (Basin Plan) incorporating a Metals TMDL for the Los Angeles River."

Page 3, Resolved paragraph 1, "Pursuant to Sections 13240 and 13242 of the California Water Code, the Regional Board, after considering the entire record, including oral testimony at the hearing, hereby readopts the amendments to Chapter 7 of the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region as set forth in Attachment A hereto, and reaffirms the decision it took in adopting Resolution No. ~~2005-006~~ R05-006, to incorporate the elements of the Los Angeles River Metals TMDL. Findings paragraphs 1 ~~through~~ through 26, and Resolved paragraphs 1 through 6 that were set forth in Resolution No. ~~2005-006~~ R05-006, are hereby incorporated by reference as though set forth in full."
