Hello all,

The comments from the City of Malibu, submitted on October 8, repeatedly describe staff's failure to consider specific studies and data prepared for the City. A list of these studies is attached.

The reports on the list have never been released by the City of Malibu to Regional Board staff despite our requests. And the figures which are provided from the reports are too small to be read (an example of a figure is provided with the list of studies).

If the City of Malibu wishes these studies to be submitted as part of the record, the entire document must be provided in a readable format, and preferably electronically, by noon tomorrow (Tuesday Oct 13th).

I spoke with Craig George concerning this issue today at 4:23 pm. He said he did not know if additional materials would be sent to us, but that he would look into it.

If the materials are not in a format which can be transmitted for staff review, they will not be included as part of the City's comments.

Further, technical results collected or evaluated after October 8 may not be presented in writing to the Board on November 5 because the public and staff will not have had sufficient time to review the material, assess its accuracy or precision, or determine its significance as part of the matter under consideration by the Board.
