

- Regional Board and State Boards approval
- Listing Policy

Section 303(d) List Los Angeles Region

- 822 waterbody/impairment combinations
 - (189 waterbodies)

 - 54% require TMDLs
 46% have completed TMDLs or other actions
- 328 factsheets for decisions to "list" OR "de-list" OR
 - "do not de-list" Or "do not list."
- 61 listings
- 30 delistings
 - 5 delistings waterbodies have met standards through TMDL implementation
