

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In the Matter of Recommended Changes to the Clean Water Act Section 303(d) List of Impaired Waters and the Clean Water Act Section 305(b) Water Quality Assessment

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lahontan Water Board will hold a public hearing at its July 8-9, 2009 meeting. Following the hearing, the Water Board will consider approving recommendations to the State Water Resources Control Board for revisions to the Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 303(d) List of impaired surface water bodies. The Water Board will not take formal action on staff's assessments of non-impaired surface waters under CWA Section 305(b). However, public comments may be submitted on these assessments, as documented in water body fact sheets. The Lahontan Water Board's recommendations will be submitted to the State Water Resources Control Board for use in a statewide "Integrated Report." The Integrated Report will be sent to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The public hearing will be held during a 2 day Water Board meeting scheduled for:
