**Subject:** Comment Letter-Proposed Underground Storage Tank Regulations



Ms. Townsend,

Additional questions came to mind when reviewing the proposed amendments:

- 1) Can CERS support this much data storage? See below, we have already heard of policy decisions to help preserve data space and we have experienced slow response times and connectivity.
- 2) How often do these documents need to be submitted under the Miscellaneous State-Required Documents section?
  - a. After initial submission - can they be or should they be removed from submittals thereafter? We have heard requests to keep them in for convenience when reviewing and then to remove them since data space is limited.
- 3) Regarding the phrase "unless otherwise directed by the agency that will receive the submittal," how must the agency provide this direction? Will the agency be required to have a local ordinance or some other formal method, or, will posting the request on their website or a verbally requesting during a monitoring certification or phone call suffice? We ask because this requirement could become subject to the unique preference of each inspector when phrased in this manner.
