OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2016/17 ALLOCATION OF 3 MILLS OF THE PETROLEUM STORAGE FEE (July 7, 2015)

The State Water Board is required annually to provide the public with an opportunity to comment on the allocation of 3 mills of the petroleum storage fee (approximately \$39.5 million) for the following three purposes (Health and Safety Code, Section 25299.43(g)(3)):

- [Replacing, Removing, or Upgrading Underground Storage Tanks \(RUST\) Program](#)
- [School District Account \(SDA\) Program](#)
- [Site Cleanup Subaccount Program \(SCAP\)](#)

The first allocation of the 3 mills was appropriated in the FY 2015/16 State Budget for RUST and SCAP in equal amounts, with no allocation to the SDA until future years when funding is needed. The second allocation of 3 mills for will be for FY 2016/17.

The opportunity for public comment on the allocation for FY 2016/17 is scheduled for the **July 21, 2015** meeting of the State Water Resources Control Board in Sacramento.
