# UST CLEANUP FUND PROGRAM UPDATE: **\*REVISED\* CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT FORM** (April 15, 2015)

The UST Cleanup Fund (Fund) has revised the Conditions of Payment form to include a new condition. (See Condition No. 17) **Effective April 20, 2015**, the newly revised form (revision 4/15) must be on file with the Fund prior to the release of any payment. The Conditions of Payment form requires a “wet” signature in order for it to be accepted. This form cannot be used to report changes to the Fund. Any modifications or incorrect information presented on the form will not be accepted. The form should be uploaded to GeoTracker through the CUF Documents portal, and the “wet” signature form **MUST** still be mailed to the Fund. The revised form can be found on the UST Cleanup Fund’s website.
