Subject: Comment Letter – Statewide Water Recycling Policy

The Central Valley Clean Water Association (CVCWA) is a consortium of 56 publicly-owned treatment works in the Central Valley. CVCWA's primary purpose is to exchange information and to provide a unified voice on regulatory issues impacting POTWs throughout the Central Valley. CVCWA members appreciate that the State Water Resources Control Board has elected to complete the process of developing a state wide policy for recycled water and encourage the Board to adopt a comprehensive policy as soon as possible. The policy is long overdue and needed by the entire state. Many of our Central Valley members recycle water in some form or another and we have long been frustrated with the lack of a state wide policy and the various regulations that are developed by the regional boards and by individual permit writers in those boards.

CVCWA supports most of the comments that were made at your March 20th workshop and support the detailed written proposals that have been provided to you by the Water Reuse Association. We especially would like to see progress made on policies that promote the use of recycled water while being protective of public health and the environment.
