To: State Water Resources Control Board
The current and proposed Water Recycling Policy does not address assistance to low-income, disadvantaged communities that have the opportunity to recycle and/or participate in (waste)water recycling projects. Many small disadvantaged communities could recycle their treated wastewater if funding was made available.

The Program should offer grant funding to small disadvantaged communities as an incentive to recycle wastewater.

We understand that program funding is restricted, but a \$300,000 to \$500,000 grant to help fund the recycled water portion (design and/or construction) of wastewater facilities that serve small disadvantaged communities could make the difference in moving ahead with the reclamation option.
