**NOTICE OF TEMPORARY PERMIT 21365 (APPLICATION T032581)**

COUNTY: Yolo

STREAM SYSTEM: Cache Creek

On January 28, 2016, Yolo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (Permittee) filed an application with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights, pursuant to Water Code section 1425, to appropriate water by temporary permit. Pursuant to Water Code section 1428, the State Water Board may issue a temporary permit in advance of public notice. Temporary Permit 21365 was issued on February 3, 2016. Source:	Cache Creek tributary to the Yolo Bypass, thence the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta
Point of Diversion:	NE¼ of SE¼ of projected Section 16, T10N, R2W, MDB&M
Amount:	40,000 acre-feet by diversion to underground storage, at a maximum rate of 200 cubic feet per second
Season:	January 1 to April 30
Purpose of Use:	Irrigation
Place of Use:	Within the boundaries of the Permittee's service area in Yolo County, as shown on map filed with the State Board.
