ORDER APPROVING ISSUANCE OF PERMIT


WHEREAS:

1. Seaver T. Page filed application 30815 with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) on November 20, 1998.
2. All protests to approval of the application have been resolved by inclusion of permit conditions and by dismissal pursuant to Water Code section 1335, subdivision (d).
3. The State Water Board has determined that there is unappropriated water available to serve Application 30815. The Applicant's consultant prepared and submitted a water availability analysis on April 25, 2007, documenting the availability of water. Division of Water Rights staff conducted a supplemental hydrologic analysis of the flow related impacts associated with approval of Application 30815 and conducted a stream habitat inventory on September 5, 2007, of the site and the unnamed stream tributary to the Russian River. Division of Water Rights staff analysis concluded that unappropriated water is available and that approval of the application, as conditioned, would not result in potentially significant impacts to anadromous fish or aquatic resources. The water will be diverted and used without unreasonable effect upon fish, wildlife, or other instream beneficial uses.
4. The water will be diverted and used without injury to any lawful user of water. The Division issued a public notice of Application 30815 on July 28, 2000. Based on the water availability analysis, water is available to serve this application without injury to prior rights. No protests based on injury to prior water rights were received.
5. The intended use is beneficial. The applicant requested to consumptively use 23 acre-feet of water stored in an existing reservoir previously authorized for non-consumptive uses under License 10708. The proposed water uses are irrigation, frost protection, and domestic. The proposed water use is beneficial.

6. Approval of this project will not result in an adverse physical change to the environment relative to the conditions that existed at the time Water Right Application 30815 was filed. The project is exempt from CEQA under California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15301. The Division will file a Notice of Exemption in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15062 after issuance of this order.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT A PERMIT IS ISSUED FOR APPLICATION 30815, subject to the conditions of the attached permit.
