Templeton CSD is proposing to drill a new water well to extract groundwater from the Salinas River underflow, for purposes of developing backup reliability for domestic water supplies, in order to serve properties located within the boundaries of the Templeton CSD. Templeton CSD will construct one well tapping the Salinas River underflow. It will serve as a backup well to the existing Smith well located upstream of the site. The Templeton CSD does not propose to extract more Salinas River underflow than is currently authorized, pursuant to its water rights permits and license. The project includes a new water transmission line running west up Creekside Ranch Drive, to a point of connection, west of the railroad tracks. The pipeline will be aligned within the County right-of-way.


