Notice is hereby given that Robert Young Family, Ltd. Partnership (Applicant) has filed for an application to appropriate water by permit. The Applicant seeks a right to store water behind an existing 24-foot high dam forming a 15 acre-foot capacity onstream reservoir with a surface area of 2 acres. In addition to reservoir inflow, supplemental water is to be diverted to the reservoir by pumping from Gird Creek via a proposed offset well. Point of Diversion (POD):	POD 1 (Goodman Reservoir) within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 27, and POD 2 (Offset Well) within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 26, both within T10N, R9W, MDB&M
Amount:	15 acre-feet per year to storage
Season:	From November 1 of each year to June 1 of the following year
Purpose of Use:	Irrigation, frost protection, heat control, fire protection, and stockwatering
Place of Use:	65 acres located within projected Sections 22, 23, 26, and 27, and uses at the reservoir located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 27, all within T10N, R9W, MDB&M
